

PROGRAM AND CURRICULUM

The Blue Water Middle College Academy curriculum will meet all requirements of the Michigan Merit Curriculum, as well as allow students to earn an associate college degree or two years worth of transferable college credit from its higher education partner, St. Clair County Community College. A typical curriculum track:

Year 9

- English: English/Language Arts 9
- Math: Geometry/Algebra I
- Science: Biology/Chemistry
- Social Studies: Civics
- P.E.: Physical Education/Health
- Language: World Language

Year 10

- English: ELA 10
- Math: Geometry/Algebra II
- Science: Biology/Chemistry/Physics
- Social Studies: U.S. History & Geography
- Language: World Language

Year 11

- English: ELA 11
- Math: Algebra II/Pre-Calculus (college-level)
- Science: Physics/Chemistry (college-level or AP)
- Social Studies: Economics/Government
- Language: World Language
- Mandatory: College Introduction to Study Skills & Michigan Association of Collegiate Registrars and Admissions Officers (MACRAO) approved elective

Year 12

- English: ELA 12/College English (Communications/Composition)
- Math: College math (e.g., Pre-Calculus)
- Science: College science
- Social Studies: College political science
- Arts: Visual and performing arts

Year 13

- Social Studies (high school): World History/Geography
- College classes (will vary as per individual student Educational Development Plan. All courses will lead to an associate degree and be eligible for transfer under MACRAO. The MMC online learning requirement also will be met via college classes).
